## ACADEMIC OVERVIEW

- **Minimum 7.5 credits per academic year**
- **Each trimester course, 60 minutes long, is worth 0.5 credits (minimum 5 courses per trimester)**
- **1 and 2 trimester courses are available with 2 trimester courses receiving 1.0 credit**
- **Differentiated College preparatory instructional levels are available including modified, regular, and honors**
- **GPA is calculated on a 4.0 weighted scale**
- **Students are ranked by their GPA; exact ranks and GPA are provided to colleges on all student transcripts**
- **Foreign language options include Latin, Spanish, French, and German**

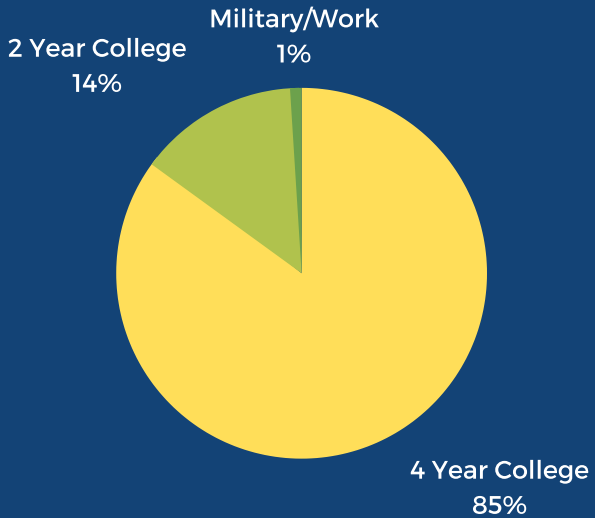
